

FIREPLACE

1. Pull out chimney cover
 2. Check that the air ventilation of cooker hood is not on boost power
 3. Turn on the fireplace switch on the living room wall
 4. Adjust combustion air control in ash box under fireplace door
 5. Start with a small amount of firewood
 6. If necessary open one of the windows a little bit
- **Fireplace switch affects the air ventilation which creates such a pressure inside the apartment that air is more easily removed through the chimney.**
 - **Make also sure that the cooker hood is not on boost power**
 - **Opening a window or balcony door will help creating a good draft in the chimney.**
 - You may burn only 2 – 3 full loads in the fireplace per day (max. 2 loads at a time), approx. 15 – 20 kg of wood. Burn only dry wood.
 - The draft may be weaker than usual during low pressure and rain.
 - When the fireplace hasn't been used for a while, that there may be an airlock in the chimney. Dry up the chimney by burning a piece of paper in the middle hatch of the fireplace. The draft is adequate when the chimney sucks up the ashes of the paper. After this it's allowed to make the fire.
 - Sudden heavy heating can damage the fireplace especially when the fireplace hasn't been used for a while.
 - Place the wood vertically at the back of the fireplace. Don't fill the fireplace with too much wood.
 - When the fireplace is not in use, keep the chimney cover closed. Especially during low pressure and rain, when using the fireplace in an adjoining apartment, smoke can enter the apartment if the chimney cover is open.
 - **NOTE! Do not close the chimney cover too soon after using fireplace! Close the chimney cover only when the embers are completely black.**
 - **Do not handle the ashes. Ash removal is carried out by staff only. Please contact reception: +358 (0) 10 382 515.**
 - Kindly refill up the firewood rack afterwards. It's easier to light the fireplace when the firewood has been indoors for a while. You can find firewood storage right outside your apartment, next to the front door. The storage key is in the hall. Thank you!

IF SMOKE COMES INTO THE APARTMENT:

- Make sure that the chimney cover is open.
- Make sure that the cooker hood is not on boost power
- Burn paper in the middle hatch of the fireplace.
- Open the apartment window or balcony door.
- There is an automatic fire alarm system in the building. **Even a small amount of smoke can release the fire alarm. If you notice that the chimney doesn't work properly, air the apartment immediately!**
