
WASHING MACHINE SIEMENS

NOTE! Turn on the water connection of the washing machine by pressing the button above the washing machine. After pressing, the water connection is on for 4 hours and then closes by automatically.

Control panel



- 1. Programmes
- 2. Programme selector
- 3. Display
- 4. Buttons

DAILY USE

Remember to turn on the water connection of the washing machine first

- 1. Turn the programme selector to a desired programme
- 2. Use the buttons to change the program settings if needed.
- 3. Press ▶.
- 4. When the program has ended, turn off the machine by turning the programme selector to \bigcirc .

Childpoof lock

Secure your appliance against being operated unintentionally using the controls.

14.1 Activating the childproof lock

- The controls are locked.
- The childproof lock remains active even after the appliance has been switched off and in the event of a power failure.

14.2 Deactivating the childproof lock

Requirement: To deactivate the childproof lock, the appliance must be switched on.

- Press and hold the two 3s buttons for approx. 3 seconds.
- 3s goes out in the display.



► (Start/Reload)	StartCancelPause	Start, cancel or pause the programme.
Speed Perfect	ActivateDeactivate	Activate or deactivate a shorter programme duration. Note: Energy consumption increases. The washing result is not affected by this.
(Ready in)	Up to 24 hours	Set the programme end. The programme duration is already included in the set number of hours. Once the programme has started, the programme duration is displayed.
°C (Temperature)	≉ − 90 °C	Adjust the temperature in °C.
(Spin speed)	Ø - 1400 rpm	Adjust the spin speed or deactivate the spin cycle. If \mathscr{G} is selected, the water is drained and the spin cycle is deactivated. The laundry stays wet inside the drum.
⇒ 3s (Child Lock 3 sec.)	ActivateDeactivate	→ "Childproof lock", Page 32
(Water & Rinse Plus)	ActivateDeactivate	Activate or deactivate a washing pro- gramme with more water and an addi- tional rinse cycle. Recommended for particularly sensit- ive skin or in regions with very soft water.
(Easy Iron)	ActivateDeactivate	Activate or deactivate the reduced creasing programme. In order to reduce creasing in the laundry, the spin cycle and the spin speed are adapted. The laundry is damp enough after washing that it needs to be hung out on a washing line.
